

Admission Information

At the Archway Schools, parents are an important partner in their child's education. We work with you and members of your sending public school district Child Study Team to help you make an informed out-of-district decision. Throughout the year, many parents call for admissions information. We are happy to help you navigate the referral/admissions process.

Admissions Q & A How do I enroll my child in The Archway Schools?

If your child, aged 3 through 21 years old, is not meeting with success in his/her current educational placement, contact the Child Study Team at your home school district.

If your child is already classified and has a current Individual Education Plan (IEP), the Case Manager will forward it to us requesting an out-of-district placement, if deemed appropriate.

If your child does not have an IEP, the CST will conduct required evaluations and develop an IEP with your input, as well as discuss placement options for your child.

If a private, out-of-district placement is the recommended option, your Case Manager will contact The Archway Schools Director of Admissions. Student records will be sent for review to determine if the referral is appropriate. If it is, our Admissions Director will contact the parent/ guardian and extend an invitation to visit our campus for an interview and tour.

What is The Archway School's admission process?

Our Director of Admissions first reviews the IEP and all other evaluations sent from your home public school. Following an admissions interview and campus tour, where you will meet Archway staff and students and have the opportunity to ask questions, our Admissions Director will contact your home public school Child Study Team with an admissions decision regarding acceptance.

May I seek admission for my child directly?

All prospective Archway School students must have the approval of their sending public school districts to enroll. A parent/ guardian is always welcome to call or make an appointment with our Admissions Director to discuss specific educational needs.

May I arrange a tour on my own?

Yes, The Archway Schools welcome school district administrators, child study Team members, teachers, and parents to contact our Director of Admissions to arrange a tour of our schools and facilities.

Do I have to pay to send my child to The Archway Schools?

No, your sending public school district is responsible for all tuition costs, which also include such special related services as Speech Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, School Social Worker, and psychiatric services.

Do I have to transport my child to The Archway Schools?

No, your sending public school district provides door-to-door transportation to and from The Archway Schools at no cost to families.
